Music by Frederick Loewe

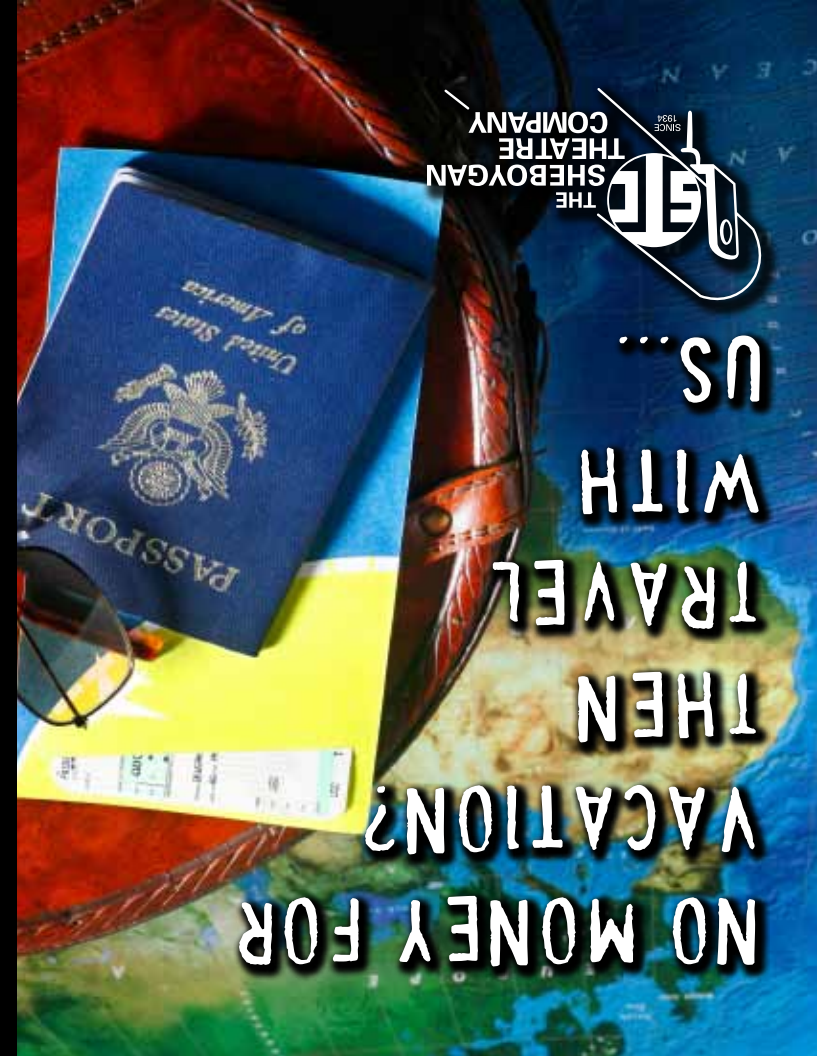

The most serious of the vignettes involves a not-so-blissfully wedded couple revisiting their honeymoon suite in an attempt to bring the love back into their marriage. Another story involves a meeting between a former movie producer and an old flame, now a suburban housewife. While she has come for nothing more than a chat between old friends, he has other plans in mind. The funniest of the acts, filled with increasingly outrageous slapstick moments, tells of a young bride who on the day of her wedding locks herself in the suite's bathroom and refuses to come out.

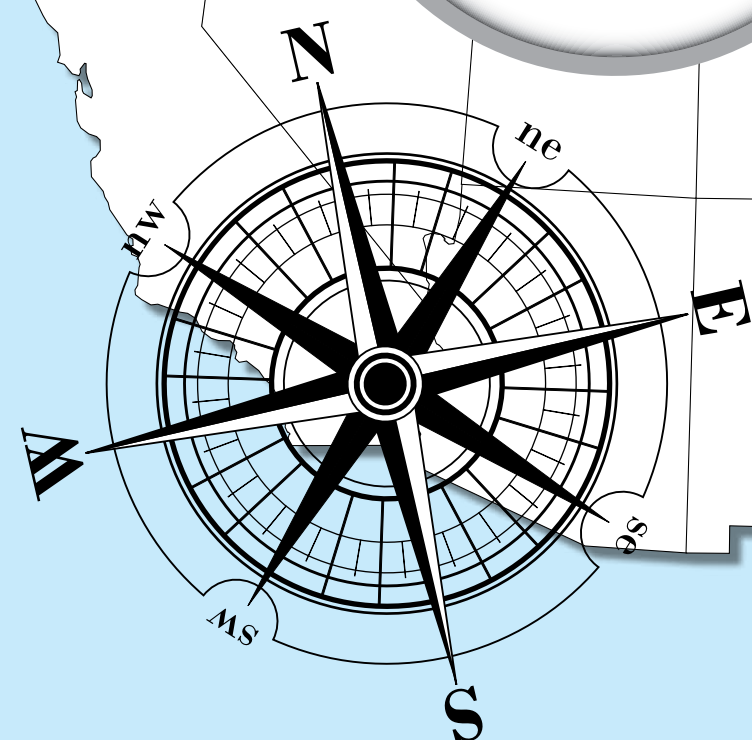
