For the audition, candidates do not need to bring prepared material. Everyone will be given numerous opportunities to audition for a variety of roles. Direction may be given, but since you will be allowed more than one opportunity, no one need feel anxious about "getting it right the first time." The audition will involve reading selected scenes from the script.

Over an eight-week period there will be approximately 24 rehearsals, the majority of which will be Mondays & Wednesdays 7:30 – 10:00 pm and Tuesdays, Thursdays, Fridays, 6:00 to 10:00 p.m.

Scripts are available for loan through the Theatre Company's office in the Community Recreation Department. They may be picked up Monday through Friday between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. but must be returned to the Community Recreation Department by 4:30 p.m. on Tuesday, January 25, 2011.
