Learning to Audition

The Sheboygan Theatre Company has a number of upcoming auditions coming in the next few weeks, “Guys and Dolls” is March 14 and the July Fourth Music Revue is March 7 and 8. First up though, will be the Audition Workshop, Saturday, March 5 from 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. at Sheboygan South High School. The workshop will be head by upcoming “Guys and Dolls” Director, Ryan Klug. Klug, who has been directing extensively throughout Wisconsin over the last several years, has a plethora of knowledge and experience about auditioning and landing roles.

The workshop will cover topics including music and music selection, monologues, cold reads, dancing, callbacks and more. Helping with the music aspects will be the well-known Sandra Kasten. For choreography, Brian Tuel will be assisting. After attending UW-Stevens Point, Tuel has performed and choreographed professionally in Wisconsin. He will also be assisting in choreography for “Guys and Dolls.”

Those interested in the workshop should prepare an up-tempo song not to exceed 32 measures. If people are only interested in non-musical audition techniques please bring along two one-minute monologues. Everyone should bring clothes to dance in.

This workshop will be two days before auditions for the Fourth of July Music Revue, directed by Sandra Kasten and eight days prior to “Guys and Dolls” auditions. It would be a great opportunity to get feedback from directors from both shows.

The workshop is available to everyone on high school age and up. It will be \$20 person. While walk-ins will be accepted but pre-registration is preferred. If there are not at least 12 participant pre-registered by March 3 the workshop will be cancelled. People can register through the Community Recreation Department, 607 S.
