The Sheboygan Theatre Company announces that open auditions for “Proof,” the third production of the Seventy-Eighth Season, will take place on Monday, December 12.

The Pulitzer-Prize winning drama is about a young, intelligent woman, Catherine, dealing with her father’s recent death. Her father was a brilliant mathematician but also had serious mental health problems. Now Catherine, who had given up a lot to take care of her father, must prove to herself and others that she can cope with life without him and the gifts or curses she may have inherited from him.

The show is comprised of a small cast, two males and two females. The male roles include, Robert, the father, who is seen in flashbacks and Hal, a former student of Robert’s. Hal has formed a bond with Catherine. The female roles are that of Catherine and her older, very put together sister, Claire.

Those auditioning do not need to prepare anything. The Director, Jennifer Stock of New York, will have people read from selected scenes from the script. Everyone will be given numerous opportunities to audition. Direction may be given, but since you will be allowed more than one opportunity, no one should feel anxious about ‘getting it right the first time.’

Initial auditions will take place at the Horace Mann Middle School Leslie W. Johnson Theatre, 2820 Union Avenue, Sheboygan, on Monday, beginning at 6:30. If callbacks are required they will be held at 6:30 on Tuesday, December 13. There will be a kick-off party, Wednesday, December 14 8:00 p.m. at Horace Mann, for anyone to meet the new director, cast and crew.

Scripts are available for loan through the Theatre Company’s office in the Community Recreation Department. They may be picked up Monday through Friday between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. but must be returned by 4:00 p.m. on Monday, December 12.
