The Sheboygan Theatre Company has two auditions coming up:

The “Guys and Dolls” auditions will take place March 14 at 6:30 p.m. and if callbacks are needed, those will take place Tuesday, March 15 at 6:30 p.m. The auditions for the Fourth of July Music Revue will be March 7 or 8 at 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. “Guys and Dolls” auditions will be in the auditorium at Horace Mann Middle School, while the Music Revue auditions will be in the Horace Mann Choir Room.

“Guys and Dolls” Artistic Director and Musical Director, Ryan Klug and Paul Sucherman, are looking for a large, highly dedicated cast who are willing to sing, dance, and perform to the highest standards. Those people cast, will rehearse March 16 till May 27 when they will perform seven public shows. Since extra rehearsals have been added, people who have conflicts during the busy spring season will have time to catch up without feeling behind.

Anyone interested in auditioning for “Guys and Dolls” should prepare 32 bars of an up-tempo song. Almost all the characters will need to have a New York/New Jersey accent, so it is recommended that those interested in auditioning work on these accents prior to auditions. “Guys and Dolls” is a dance heavy show, and the artistic staff fully intends to stretch the limits of area talent in the choreography. Everyone should bring clothes appropriate for dance to the audition.

The Music Revue will have a much more laid back rehearsal schedule with rehearsals beginning early April about two times a week. More days will be added as needed and as it gets closer to the one performance on July 4, 2011 at Fountain Park. Sandra Kasten, the director for the revue, wants to start the rehearsals sooner so people have time to learn and won’t feel so rushed to memorize and be ready to perform. Open auditions are available both days but those auditioning only have to come to one.

Those auditioning should prepare a one to two minute song that best demonstrates their vocal quality and showmanship. Kasten is looking for a cast of five to ten adult singers who will sing selections from the Broadway repertoire, including the musicals of Sheboygan Theatre Company’s 2011/2012 season, as well as patriotic songs.
