We will be having open auditions for anyone High School age or older who wants to be in the show on Monday night, with Callbacks on Tuesday night. Anyone interested in auditioning should prepare 32 bars of an up-tempo song in the style of the show. We will be looking to cast the show "age appropriately," but that shouldn't discourage anyone from auditioning for any role they're interested in. Everyone should bring clothes appropriate for dance.

•**Miss Adelaide** - (age - mid 30's +) Comic, classic showgirl and gambler's moll. RANGE - Mezzo Soprano, A - D

All characters (with exception of Mission Band members, Sarah, Arvide, General Cartwright, and Big Jule) must have a New York/New Jersey accent. It is highly recommended that those interested in auditioning work on these accents prior to auditions. "Guys and Dolls" is a dance heavy show, and we fully intend to stretch the limits of area talent in the choreography.

We are adding two weeks to the rehearsal period in hopes that we can extensively rehearse these high energy production numbers. Also, people who have conflicts during the busy spring season will have time to catch up without feeling behind, so please let us be the judge of whether you're too busy to participate!
